Working to "heal their hidden wounds"

Operation Warrior Shield/ VETWELL is currently offering specialized holistic wellness services to address stress, anxiety and the most common conditions faced by today's Veterans, including family relationships, sleep deprivation, nutritional counseling and other issues. An initial pilot study of 25 Veterans, conducted in 2019, rendered measurable results in pain management, stress reduction, and "improved quality of life".

Training in Transcendental Meditation (TM) is also offered as part of this program, and this simple, easy to learn practice has resulted in a 40-55% reduction in symptoms of PTSD and depression, a 42% increase in insomnia, and a 30% improvement in quality of life. This training is provided at no cost by the David Lynch Foundation, a not-for-profit that has provided scholarships for more than one million at-risk adults and children, including Veterans with PTS and their families.

Future plans include expansion of this program thru VetConnectNYC and leading VSOs (Veterans Service organizations).



Dear Friend,

According to the VA's national suicide data report, 22 Veterans commit suicide daily, which means that every 65 minutes one of our heroes takes their own life in despair. And as suicide rates increase by more than 10% among younger Veterans, it is a clarion call to action.

That is why Operation Warrior Shield, founded in 2016, by CMSgt (ret'd), Ed Schloeman, is reaching out to assist military, and their families, who fight a daily battle for a better quality of life and a path to inner and outer health and well being. Operation Warrior Shield (a 501c-3) provides comprehensive programs for Veterans, Active Military, and First Responders, which includes training in the nonreligious modality of Transcendental Meditation (TM), and an evidence based program of Vibroacoustic Therapy for stress reduction. This training helps to "heal their hidden wounds" and prepares the Veteran to return to a more normal life, including efforts at employment and ending homelessness.

Joining in this battle is Commissioner of Veterans Services NYC, Brig Gen (ret'd)/MD Loree Sutton, a spokesperson for VetConnectNYC, which is a referral platform serving over 250,000 NY Metro area military in the areas of housing, employment, education, legal and wellness. "With the official launch of VetConnectNYC (an affiliate of America Serves), we strive to make the transition for our City's service members and their families a priority. And I am thrilled to work with our tremendous partners on this bold and noble mission", says Brig Gen Sutton.

Operation Warrior Shield and its Founder Ed Schloeman have received numerous awards, including selection as the "best emerging not for profit of 2017" by the Brooklyn Chamber of Commerce. Its leadership includes Chairman Schloeman, Secty Lt Col (R) Patrick Kernan, Special Advisor/ Veterans Advocate, Anne Akers and our working partners, the David Lynch Foundation, NYC Veterans Services, and T-Mobile.
